

<u>Please note:</u> Pier bidding day will be on Saturday, March 6th, 2010 at 12:00 noon and Launch Day will be on May 8th this year. Remember all fees for the summer must be paid by this Launch Day. This includes the trailerable boats also. <u>All boats are to be insured while using South Milwaukee Yacht Club facilities</u> (Harbor, <u>Storage</u>, Ramp, and Crane). Submit a Certificate of Insurance to SMYC in care of the Fleet Captain before it expires during the boating season.
